CHURCH DOCTRINE

WE BELIEVE THIS DOCTRINE IS THE WAY OF OUR CHURCH:

GOD: is the eternal and infinite spirit, the creator, supreme being who created and preserves all things. Scripture speaks of "the Word of God meaning "the things God has said." Hebrew Bible Elohim usually refers to the monotheistic Creator God, or to the God of Israel, Yahweh, (Isaiah 42:8)- I am Jehovah, that is my name; and my glory will not give to another, neither my praise unto graven images., The sovereign of the universe.

CHRIST: Greek Etymology meaning "anointed one "an appellation given to the Savior of the World, and it was a custom of antiquity to consecrate persons to the sacerdotal and regal offices by anointing them with oil. Jesus the Christ the Great Deliver, the Anointed One, the Savior of men. This name denotes that Jesus was divinely appointed, commissioned, and accredited as the Savior of men. (Hebrew 5:4: Isaiah 11:2-4: John 5:37; Acts 2:22). Also, meshiah (Messiah), meaning "the anointed one." He is the man who Christian's believe is the son of God and whose life, death, and resurrection as reported in the New Testament of the Bible are the basis of the Christian religion.

THE HOLY SPIRIT: (John 14:26)- But the comforter, which is the Holy Ghost whom the Father will send in my name, he shall

teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Romans: (8:26)- Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities; for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

2 Corinthians: (3:17)- Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

Romans: (15:13)- Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost.

John: (14:15-17)- If ye love me, keep my commandments.

Acts: (2:38)- Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Continue: Galatians (5:22-23), 1 Corinthians (6:19), Isaiah (11:2), John (16:12-15), Luke (11:13), Acts (1:8), John (16: 7-15), Ezekiel (36:26-27), 1 Corinthians (2:13), Ephesians (1:13).

THE BIBLE: King James Version has 5 editions an Early 1611, 1629,1638,1762 and 1769. English Bishop's Bible carried out under James 1. published Modern English Translated over 360 years ago. translation of the Christian Bible for the Church of England. "The Word of God to humankind."

SALVATION: Ephesians (2:8-9) For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Romans: (10:9)- That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

Titus: (3:5)- Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost.

John: (14:6)- Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

John: (3:16)- For God So loved the world, that he gave up his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

John: (3:36)- He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the Wrath of God abideth on him.

Mark: (16:16)- He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Continue: Psalms (3:8), Psalms (37:39), Acts (4:12), Romans (5:8), Matthew (7:21), Romans (8:1).

THE CHURCH: First mentioned Mathew (16:18) when Jesus speaks of building. "His Church" tells Peter he will build it. He is the Christ, the Son of the Living God. The Lord's house.

Acts: (19:32,39,41)- (32) Some therefore cried one thing, and some another: for the assembly was confused: and the more part knew not wherefore they were come together. (39) But if ye enquired anything concerning other matters, it shall be determined in a lawful assembly. (41) And when he had thus spoken, he dismissed the assembly.

ANGELS: Psalms (91:11)- For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all the ways.

Hebrews: (13:2)- be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

Matthew: (24:31)- And he shall send his angels with a great sound of trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Psalms: (103:20)- Bless the LORD, ye the angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word.

Continue: Mathew (18:10), Revelations (19:10), Jude (1:6), Psalms (34:7), Hebrew (1:14).

END OF TIME: Matthew (24:36)- But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.

Luke: (21:36)- Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.

Matthew: (24:42)- Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour the Lord doth come.

2 Peter: (3:10-13)- But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. (11)- *Seeing* then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in *all* holy conversation and godliness, (12)- Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat? (13)- Nevertheless we, accordingly to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

Continue: 2 Timothy (3:1-5), Matthew (24:44), Joel (2:28-32, 2) Peter (3:3-7), Luke (21:11), Matthew (24:13), Ephesians (2:12), Matthew (24:21-22), Acts (17:30-31), 2 Thessalonians (2:3-4), Matthew (7:13-14), Romans (13:11), Zechariah (8:1-6), Matthew (24 1-51), Isaiah (2:4).

THE DEVIL: Lucifer is regarded within the Latter-Day Saint movement as a pre-mortal name of the devil. In heavenly council, Lucifer rebelled against the plan of God the Father and was subsequently cast out.

James 4:7- Submit yourself therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

SCRIPTURE: Christians know the Scriptures are God's Word because in them they hear the voice of the Lord. As Jesus declared, "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me" -John (10:27). John (5:39)- "you search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about me."

PRAYER: Hebrews (10:22) acceptable prayer must be sincere and offered with reverence and godly fear, with a humble sense of our own insignificance as creatures and of our own unworthiness as sinners, with earnest importunity, and with unhesitating submission to the divine will.

Matthew: (6:5-8)- Jesus' said that prayer should be a private time between God and the worshipper. Jesus does not mean that it is wrong to pray with others, but the prayers should be sincere and for the right motives.

Prayer helps you develop a relationship with God.

1 Samuel: (1:10)- Hannah went to Tabernacle and prayed with great weeping, while Eli High priest was sitting on a chair near the doorpost. In her prayer, she asked God for a son and in return she vowed to give her son back to God for the service of God.

GRACE: Grace is God's kindness, His gracious generosity, His undeserved favour and spiritual blessing. The Apostle Paul wrote in Ephesians: (2:8-9)- "for by grace are ye saved through

faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.”

Grace freely given, unmerited favor and love of God.

COMMUNITY: Psalms (133:1-3)- How Pleasant It Is When God's People Live Together in Unity. There is a special kind of joy that we experience when we are together in unity with other believers.

The 9th of Ten Commandments: Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor. Has roots in integrity and honesty.

The 10th Commandments: Thou shalt not cover thy neighbor's goods. They shall not covet thy neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbor's.

FELLOWSHIP: John (1 1:3)- That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship(is) with the father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.

“For where two or three are gathered in my name, there I am with them”: **Matthew**: (18:20 NIV). Listen, with hearing ears, to that promise: When we gather in His name, He is with us! Hallelujah!

Corinthians: (1:19)- God sees us as being in fellowship, a deep and direct relationship, with Him, with Christ.

John: (1 1:7)- But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

MARRIAGE: Genesis (2:24)- MARRIAGE between a MAN and a WOMAN was instituted by GOD with ADAM and EVE.

“Therefore, a man (Man: 100 % Natural that God Created) leaves his father and his mother and cleaves to his wife, (Woman: 100% Natural that God Created) and they become one flesh.” (married, united as man(natural) and woman(natural)).

***Note:** (-) is explanation of what God Created and who he speaks of in marriage. Remember if your natural parents did not believe this **you** would **not** be here either! Amen!

Proverbs: (12:4)- “An excellent wife is the crown of her husband, but she who shames him is as rottenness in his bones.”

Acts: (19:23-27) is the story of how people often value money and civil identity more than the freedom and salvation found in Christ.

God's Country Farm Fellowship: one of our top missions in ministry by us fellowshiping with the people and missionaries everywhere to **Acts:** (3:21)- Heaven must receive him until the time comes for God to restore everything, as he promised long ago through his holy prophets.

Galatians: (6:1)- Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently. But watch yourselves, or you also may be tempted.

Hosea: (6:1)- “Come, let us return to the Lord.” He has torn us to pieces, but he will heal us; he has injured us, but he will bind up our wounds.

Isaiah: (40:31)- but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary; they will walk and not be faint.

1 Peter: (5:10)- And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm, and steadfast.

Job: (42:10)- After Job had prayed for his friends, the Lord restored his fortunes and gave him twice as much as he had before.

Mark: (11:24)- Therefore, I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.

Matthew: (6:33)- But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Matthew: (1:28)- ‘Come to me’, all who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.

Plasms: (51:12)- Restore unto me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

Romans: (15:13)- May the God fill you up with joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
